GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Orders from the Illinois Supreme Court and the Chief Judge of Madison County, courts are to conduct as many hearings as possible through remote means. Beginning with the June 11, 2020 docket, all hearings for the undersigned will be held over Zoom. Litigants who do not have Zoom can use a terminal at the courthouse in Edwardsville to attend. The parties will need to navigate to the Circuit Clerk's website and click on the link Court Schedule For Zoom Hearings and then click the Zoom meeting link for the docket for the time and date you are to appear.

After you click on the link you will be placed in a waiting room or breakout room until your case is called.

All litigants are encouraged to confer with the opposing side regarding the entry of agreed orders, which can be emailed to the undersigned and thus avoid appearing.
