By the time he completed his studies, he had been recognized with several academic and service honors, including the Law and Technology Concentration, the Pro Bono Commitment to Community Award, the Dean's Scholarship Award, a CALI Excellence Award in Trade Secret Law, and the Best Brief Award in the school's Walter H. Rice Moot Court Competition.
